

ATTENTION LASSEN COUNTY VOTERS

You will NOT have a traditional polling place during the November 3, 2020 General Election, because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Lassen County is adhering to federal guidance and the State's stay-at-home requirements as directed in the Gubernatorial Executive Order, statutes, and the California Department of Public Health directives and guidance in response to the COVID-19 emergency. Every voter in California was mailed a ballot.

Voters are encouraged to MAIL their ballot early. If you do not want to mail your ballot you can drop it off at the County Clerk's Election office at 220 South Lassen Street, Annex in Susanville.

Official Drop Boxes are located behind the Historic Courthouse and at the Fire Station in Janesville, available 24/7 up to 8 PM on Election Night.

The Election Office and the Janesville Fire Station will be open to assist voters on Saturday, October 31; Sunday, November 1; and Monday, November 2 from 8 AM to 5 PM; and on Election Day, Tuesday November 3, 2020 from 7 AM to 8 PM.
