

NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the offices for which candidates are to be nominated at the Statewide Direct Primary Election to be held on Tuesday June 7, 2022, are as follows: County Supervisor–District 3; County Supervisor–District 5; Assessor; Auditor; Clerk/Recorder; Sheriff/Coroner; County Superintendent of Schools; Treasurer/Tax Collector; City Councilmember*. Polling locations will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day:

QUALIFICATIONS (ALL OFFICES)

The California Elections Code requires all candidates for public office in California to be registered voters and otherwise qualified to vote for the office they are seeking at the time their nomination papers are issued. The constitutional requirements to be a registered voter are that a person must be a United States citizen, at least 18 years of age, not in prison for conviction of a felony, and not determined by a court of law to be mentally incompetent.

Beyond these general qualifications, some offices require more specific qualifications, and proof that candidates meet these qualifications. Additional qualifications and filing fee amounts can be obtained from the County Clerk's office.

Dates & Filing Deadlines: Friday, March 11, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. is the end of candidate filing period and last day to submit a resolution of consolidation for the June Primary. Candidates may obtain Nomination Papers and file their official Declarations of Candidacy at the office of the Lassen County Clerk, in the Historic Courthouse at 220 S Lassen St., Suite 5, Susanville, CA. If the incumbent does not file by March 11, 2022, the filing deadline is extended through March 16, 2022, at 5:00 p.m., for anyone other than the incumbent.
