 - a. Swearing in of New Board Member:
 - i. Gary Bridge swore in Andrea Hernandez for her position on the Lassen County Behavioral Health Advisory Board Committee.
 - ii. Oath of Office signed by all parties
- 2. Mobile Crisis Unit Tiffany Armstrong
 - a. Plan has been received back from the State
 - i. Lots of comments and questions
 - ii. TA call was held but information was not useful
 - 1. Unfamiliar with rural counties
 - 2. No information on billing private insurance
 - 3. No funding for stand by time or funding to off set cost of waiting for calls

- 4. Must have 3 individuals One licensed who is able to beam in one trained in Narcan One responding available to respond
- 5. Many areas of the county will not be able to be reached in the 120-minute time frame
- iii. Most of cohort 1 has been approved and rolling out this month
- iv. Lassen County was put in with the larger counties
 - 1. Many of the larger counties already had a type of mobile crisis unit
- v. Went out for RFP to cover for afterhours response
 - 1. Received no interest
- vi. County will start getting sanctioned for not following requirements
 - 1. Unsure what the sanctions will be at this time

 - v. 10 units will be available for individuals with SMI and/or SUD diagnosis who are experience homelessness

 - 2. Incentives can provide funding to help improve/build units
