Consultants:

California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 18701(a)(2) defines "consultant" as an individual who, pursuant to a contract with a state or local government agency:

(A) Makes a governmental decision whether to:

(i) Approve a rate, rule, or regulation;

(ii) Adopt or enforce a law;

(iii) Issue, deny suspend, or revoke any permit, license, application, certificate, approval, order or similar authorization or entitlement;

(iv) Authorize the agency to enter into, modify, or renew a contract provided it

is the type of contract which requires agency approval;

(v) Grant agency approval to a contract which requires agency approval and in which the agency is a party or to the specifications for such a contract;

(vi) Grant agency approval to a plan, design, report, study, or similar item;

(vii) Adopt, or grant agency approval of, policies, standards, or guidelines for the agency, or for any subdivision thereof;
-OR-

(B) Serves in a staff capacity with the agency and in that capacity performs the same or substantially all the same duties for the agency that would otherwise be performed by an individual holding a position specified in the agency's Conflict of Interest Code.

It is not the business or firm providing services to the County that is considered the consultant. The **individual(s)** working for the firm who provide the services are considered the consultants. These individuals must file statements of economic interests based on their **personal** financial interests and are subject to disqualification and other laws affecting public officials.

The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a designated position, is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited-in scope and thus is not required to comply fully with the disclosure requirements. Such determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The CAO's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.

APPENDIX B DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

Category 1

Persons in this category shall disclose all interests in real property within the jurisdiction. Real property shall be deemed to be within the jurisdiction if the property or any part of it is located within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the jurisdiction or within two miles of any land owned or used by the local government agency.

Persons shall not be required to disclose property used primarily as their residence or for personal recreational purposes.

Category 2

Persons in this category shall disclose all investments.

"Investment" means any financial interest in or security issued by a business entity, including but not limited to common stock, preferred stock, rights, warrants, options, debt instruments and any partnership or other ownership interest, owned directly, indirectly, or beneficially by the public official, or other filer, or his or her immediate family, if the business entity or any parent, subsidiary or otherwise related business entity has an interest in real property in the jurisdiction, or does business or plans to do business in the jurisdiction, or has done business within the jurisdiction at any time during the two years prior to the time any statement or other action is required under this title. No asset shall be deemed an investment unless its fair market value equals or exceeds two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). The term "investment" does not include a time or demand deposit in a financial institution, shares in a credit union, any insurance policy, interest in a diversified mutual fund registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission under the Investment Company Act of 1940 or a common trust fund created pursuant to Section 1564 of the Financial Code, or any bond or other debt instrument issued by any government or government agency. Investments of an individual includes a prorata share of investments of any business entity, mutual fund, or trust in which the individual or immediate family owns, directly, indirectly, or beneficially, a ten percent interest or greater. The term "parent, subsidiary or otherwise related business entity" shall be specifically defined by regulations of the commission. (Government Code § 82034.)

Category 3

Persons in this category shall disclose all income received from any source located or doing business within the jurisdiction or expecting to do business within the jurisdiction. Income received from a public agency need not be disclosed.

Category 4

Persons in this category shall disclose all income from and investments in businesses that provide or sell services or supplies of the type associated with job assignment and utilized by the Department.

Category 5

Persons in this category shall disclose all items (including real property) valued over \$460.00 received as a gift, purchased from, or sold to any person applying for or receiving any services from the Department.

Category 6

Persons in this category shall disclose all business positions held in business entities which are located or doing or expecting to do business within the jurisdiction and which business entities may foreseeably be affected materially by any decision made or participated in by the person by virtue of his or her position. "Business Entity" as used herein includes both for-profit and non-profit entities.
