A Deputy Sheriff Recruit is a non-peace officer employee who is attending a Law Enforcement Academy certified by California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) in preparation of becoming a Deputy Sheriff. The major duties of this job include:

- Maintain passing scores in all assigned coursework, quizzes, and tests.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training: Graduation from High School or attainment of a satisfactory score on the

G.E.D. test, as required for admittance to the P.O.S.T. Academy.

Experience: Experience in law enforcement and/or security preferred.

License and Valid California driver's license. Successful completion of P.O.S.T. Academy

Certifications: after appointment.

Special Requirements: Must be at least 18 years of age, with no felony convictions. Must be available to

attend the law enforcement academy; must be a citizen of the United States or a permanent resident alien who has applied for citizenship at least one year prior to application for employment in accordance with section 1031.5 of the Government Code; must successfully complete an extensive background investigation in relationship to past history including having good credit and being of good moral

character.
