Our Services

System Supports

- **Community Development Block Grants (CDBG)**

CDBG grants support community development activities to build stronger and more resilient communities.

- **Housing Development**

Staff work to secure grants for housing services and supports and to develop affordable housing in Lassen County.

- **Community Engagement**

Community engagement includes participation in the NorCal CoC, community education and partnership development and partnership development.

Housing Assistance

- **Housing Navigation**

Staff assists individuals and families in finding, applying for, securing, and moving into housing.

- **Housing Case Management**

Case management focuses on navigating barriers to housing and helping individuals and families connect to supports.

- **Financial Assistance**

Financial assistance can include rental assistance, security deposit assistance, utility payments, moving cost assistance, and interim housing assistance.

Street Outreach

- **Housing Focused**

The goal of street outreach is to build engagement and connect individuals living outside to housing.

- **Connection to Resources**

Outreach staff connects individuals and families to services, such as health care, transportation, access to benefits, and more.

- **Survival Supplies**

Outreach staff can provide supplies to people living outside, such as food, water, clothing, blankets, and other necessities.

Available services can vary based on eligibility requirements and available funding.
